Boston University DURC Review Process

Research Planning

PI reviews project to determine if it meets any of the DURC criteria. (IBC may identify a project as having DURC potential).

PI carries out ongoing assessment to determine if a project evolves into DURC

Initial Assessment (DURRC* subcommittee)

Projects involving any of the 15 agents are reviewed by a subcommittee of the DURRC. If the subcommittee determines the project meets the definition of DURC it will be forwarded to the full DURRC.

DURRC review and action

The DURRC carries out a risk/benefit assessment and develops a risk mitigation plan**. The mitigation plan is developed in consultation with the PI and the Office of the General Council. Findings are reported to appropriate US government agency.
