

SPANISH MINOR

Take **SIX** four-credit LS courses in these categories:

FOUNDATION COURSES

Up to three courses numbered LS 212-349 taught on the Charles River campus or via a Study Abroad program, including an internship conducted in Spanish.

(We recommend a max of two courses numbered LS 300-349.)

GATEWAY COURSES

LS 350: Introduction to Literature

UPPER- DIVISION COURSES

Two or more courses at the LS 400-500 level on literature, film, or media from the Spanish-speaking world.

(For Study Abroad courses in this category, speak with an advisor before going abroad.)

- **Have advanced standing or AP credit?** Start your minor coursework at your current level.
- **Heritage or native speaker?** Start with LS 309 Spanish for Heritage/Native Speakers or LS 350, or consult with an advisor.
