

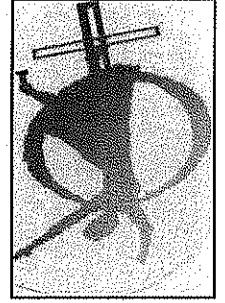

Our leaders will present their findings and lead our discussions, exploring new visions of American multicultural ministry from Latina, Asian, and African Immigrant experiences.

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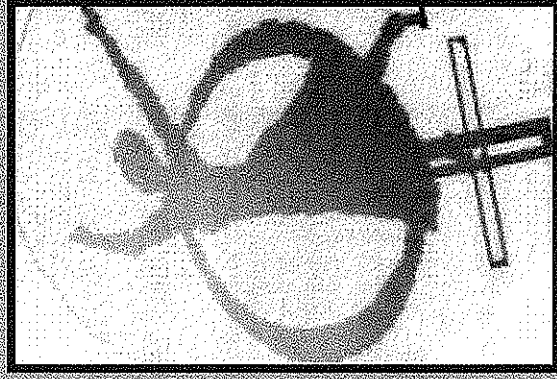

Presenters

Rev. Dr. Aida Iritzary-Fernandez: An Elder in the United Methodist Church and clinical social worker, Aida Iritzary-Fernandez has a D. Min. specializing in counseling and community organizing. She is the District Superintendent for the Metropolitan Boston Hope District, New England Conference of the United Methodist Church. She often serves as preacher, lecturer, and bible study leader across the Denomination.

Rev. Laurel Scott: Laurel E. Scott is the current Anna Howard Shaw Scholar at Boston University School of Theology, where she is a candidate for the Th.D. degree in Practical Theology. An Elder in the United Methodist Church, she pastors a Massachusetts church with a large percentage of immigrants and is involved in Justice Ministries, including ministry among immigrant workers.

Dr. M.T. Davila, Boston College: M.T. Davila received her Ph.D. in May in Theological Ethics from Boston College, specializing in social ethics, the option for the poor, U.S. civil society, and liberation issues. She will be Assistant Professor of Christian Ethics at Andover Newton Theological School beginning in the Fall of 2008.

Rev. Dr. Choi Hee An, Boston University School of Theology: A faculty member and Director of the Anna Howard Shaw Center at Boston University School of Theology, Choi Hee An teaches Practical Theology and conducts research on women in immigrant churches. She is the author of *Korean Women and God* and co-editor of *Engaging the Bible: Critical Readings from Contemporary Women*. She is an ordained minister in the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ).

Rev. Yoo-Yun Cho-Chang, Boston University: Yoo-Yun is an Elder in the United Methodist Church and a candidate for the Ph.D. degree in Counseling Psychology and Religion at Boston University. She has received United Methodist Women of Color Scholarship and is currently serving as a psychology intern at the Danielsen Institute at Boston University.
