The ULT Freezer Replacement Program has officially launched, today, Monday, January 27th. Applications for funding approval are now being accepted.

We strongly encourage interested laboratories to submit their applications promptly, as funding will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. As a reminder, incentives for replacing an existing ULT freezer through this program include \$2,500 from the University/Medical Campus Deans and an additional \$1,000 from BU Sustainability. Cash incentives are available to faculty in BU-affiliated spaces whose grants utilize BU purchasing, applicable on both the Charles River and Medical Campuses. Please note that the Medical Campus program is limited to a total of 25 units.

Upgrading to a new freezer will enhance the protection of valuable, often irreplaceable research samples, contribute to reducing the University's energy consumption, and ensure optimal insurance coverage for the research community.
