Student Representatives are elected members of the Student Senate Representative Committee. The Student Senate works to foster a respectful, collaborative, diverse and inclusive community within SPH to promote holistic student success; to hold the faculty, staff and university community accountable to the mission and values of SPH by acting as a liaison for student voices; and to ignite positive change beyond our academic walls through engaging with people, communities and institutions to promote justice, human rights and equity. The position will aid in all three of these areas with a particular focus on acting as a liaison for student voices. The members of this committee are not voting members of the Executive Board.

Responsibilities

As a member of the Student Representative Committee, Student Representatives will:

- Attend all meetings arranged by the Student Senate. This includes monthly Student Representative Committee meetings and monthly General Student Body meetings. If any member of the board is unable to attend for any reason, adequate notice must be given to the Internal Relations Coordinator
- Attend all events arranged by or in partnership with the Student Senate
- Assist in the execution of Student Senate hosted events
- Conduct themselves with academic integrity and exemplary conduct

Student Representatives specifically will:

- Act as point of contact for designated student population
- Recruit and maintain student presence at the General Student Body meetings
- Report to the Internal Relations Coordinator regarding designated student population concerns
- Assist the Social Media & Promotions Coordinator with posting Student Senate information on BUSPH student groups and pages
- Promote use of the student feedback form
- Communicate student body input at Executive Board and Faculty Senate meetings, on a rotating basis with the other representatives

Qualifications for this position:

- Availability for the full Student Representative term, one semester beginning in September 2019 and ending in December 2019.
- Applicants must be full or part-time BUSPH students throughout their tenure.
