Pastoral Resident Full- Time, Exempt

Purpose: To serve Bethany Community Church by providing opportunities to fulfill the mission statement: inviting people to God, community, and wholeness. We believe the church has a call to invest in the next generation of pastoral leaders as a contributing effort to build future healthy churches. One of the ways we accomplish this is by employing pastors early on in their career in residency positions where they are given the opportunity to form healthy patterns of life and ministry while doing important pastoral work in the context of a local church and with the resources of experienced pastors and staff members. This allows residents to explore ideas, programming, and the day-to-day roles of a pastor in a supportive and experienced environment.

The Pastoral Resident will serve as a full member of Bethany's pastoral ministry team and is expected to have experienced a clear call to vocational ministry, possessing the requisite competencies to serve as a pastor at Bethany. Pastoral Residents will be mentored and equipped as they develop the ability and skills necessary to be a healthy pastor within the context of a local church.

Similar to a medical residency at a teaching hospital, pastoral residents hold a unique position in the church being both a pastor, with the responsibility and authority that comes with that position, as well as a pastor-in-training, developing his/her own gifts and understanding of his/her unique call in vocational ministry.
