



Open Clinical Positions at The Brookline Center

These clinical positions offer affiliation with the Brookline Center's exceptional community of clinicians, granting access to a rich array of clinician development resources, weekly+ clinical consultation and discussion opportunities, and a culture with a deep commitment to the mental health needs of our clients and community. If you are primarily interested in working with youth and parents within the context of their primary care practices in a salaried role...

Behavioral Health Clinician, Collaborative Care – This is a full time, salaried/benefitted and hybrid/remote position for a licensed, post-Masters clinician that is embedded within a primary care practice located in Arlington, MA. The clinician will provide short-term, evidence-based behavioral health interventions to clients across the lifespan and incorporate measurement-based care as part of their treatment approach with patients. This position is a member of the Outpatient team as well as the Collaborative Care team, an [Innovation Institute](#) pilot project.

If you are seeking generalist experience with clients across the diagnostic, service, and age spectrum with flexibility to work part-full time in benefitted-fee-for-service or fee-for-service roles...

Outpatient Clinician - There are currently benefitted-fee-for-service and fee-for-service positions available for post-Masters clinicians at every level of license. Clinicians hold a hybrid schedule, working part-time out of our Brookline office and/or the community, to deliver care to folks across the lifespan. Offering individual, family, couples, and group therapy, our providers are busy with dynamic and varied caseloads. Clinicians also participate in various supervision, continuous learning, and team meetings throughout the week.

If you are seeking a role embedded in the community, with a diverse set of duties, including managing relationships with local Housing Authority and Department of Public Health, consider this salaried role...

Community Clinician- This is a full-time, salaried/benefitted and hybrid/remote position for a licensed, post-Masters clinician that would work with residents referred by the Brookline Department of Public Health and residents living at Brookline Housing Authority in Brookline, MA. The clinician would provide short-term, evidence-based behavioral health interventions and/or support to adult clients coping with a range of mental health areas that may be impacting their housing status (i.e. at-risk tenancy, collecting behaviors, depression, etc.). There would be opportunities to facilitate/co-facilitate training and workshops for clients and staff of BHA and BDPH on various topics. This position is a member of the Outpatient and Community teams and supervision and opportunities for continuous professional development would be provided.
