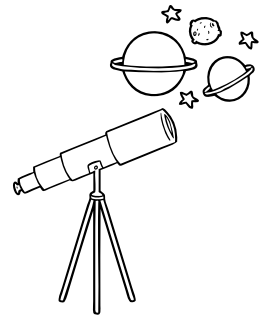
### Stargazing at BU Coit Observatory

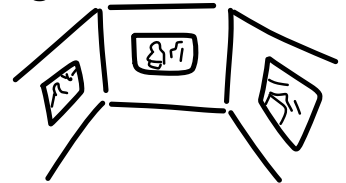
