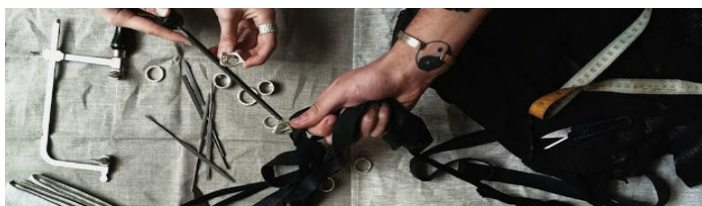


Sydney Design 2015
