

## **FLM: Outlining**

### **In-Class Activity**

#### *Online Implementation*

**Goal:** To practice distinguishing the relative importance of ideas in a text.

**Task:** Your teacher will put you in a break-out room with 2-3 other students. In your group, practice creating an outline of a text your professor has assigned - you can collaborate on your outline in a shared Google doc or by creating a simple Padlet, with text boxes used to represent different parts of the outline.

Next, you will be asked to exchange your outline with another team, by either sharing your Google doc or Padlet with them.

Finally, you will be placed in your original break-out room again. Read the other team's outline and work with your group to review and evaluate that outline's effectiveness as a visual representation of the reading material. Consider taking some notes in your Google doc or in the Zoom chat (just make sure to save your chat notes before the break-out rooms are closed!).
