



#### **Academic Exploration**

Your BU "Support Squad" includes multiple staff who will provide support and advice as you explore and experience all that BU has to offer. In addition to your academic advisor(s), staff from the <u>Student Success team</u> are here to support you through your first year at BU. First-year students all have an <u>Assistant Director of First-Year Success (AD)</u>. You can talk with your AD about anything that's on your mind but common topics include: your goals for college, how to get involved, and good ways to make friends.
