For CAS students exploring external credit

Students can search for external courses through two websites:

Transferology

<u>Transferology</u> sorts all previously evaluated transfer courses by the BU equivalent. For example, you can search for CAS EC 101 equivalents only.

Transfer Equivalency Site

The <u>Transfer Equivalency Site</u> (<u>TES</u>) is a database of all transfer courses previously evaluated for BU credit. It's sorted by institution.

Transfer Credit Policy FAQs

- Transfer courses do not fulfill Hub requirements.
- You must earn a C or higher; Pass/Fail or Satisfactory/ Unsatisfactory grades will not be accepted.
- The transfer course grades will not factor into your BU GPA.
- Non-BU international courses must adhere to a different process and policy. You can find more information on our website.

- Credits will be awarded based on the external institution (e.g., 3 units at a semester system will be 3 units at BU: 3 untits at a quarter system will be 2 units at BU).
- CAS students may not be enrolled at another institution while enrolled at BU in the fall and spring semesters.
 - Courses taken over the summer or while on a leave of absence are accepted.
- Official transcripts must be sent from the external institution directly to BU's Credit Evaluation Office.
