BU Wheelock Student Safety Clinical Guidelines

Boston University's highest priority is the safety and health of our students and the communities they serve. The ways in which students participate in their fieldwork varies among academic programs and is determined by a range of factors including but not limited to site policies and procedures, program requirements, licensure regulations, and accreditation standards.

For in-person fieldwork, BU Wheelock students **must** adhere to the following University guidelines:

- Commit to site policies and procedures specifically related to COVID-19, <u>including</u>
 <u>providing proof of vaccination and booster directly to the site if required</u>;
- Comply with local, state, and federal guidelines related to social distancing to protect themselves and individuals they will be in contact with;
- Use the <u>COVID Related Field Site Checkpoints</u> to obtain essential COVID related information from the site supervisor and/or site administrator;
 - Field sites are sent a copy of these checkpoints as well.
- Communicate with the academic program and <u>Office of Disability & Access Services</u> any concerns about personal health or safety;
